BC Provincial Election - IVR Results

Results are based on completed interviews and weighted by Age, Gender and Region. Percentages may not total 100% because of rounding. The margin of error for the poll is $\pm 2.9\%$, at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample.

METHODOLOGY

Population	British Columbia residents aged 18+
Collection method	IVR using random digit dialing. Respondents confirmed they were at least 18 years old and eligible to vote.

Weighting dimensions	Age, Gender and Region in British Columbia according to Statistics Canada and BC Stats Population Estimates, 2026

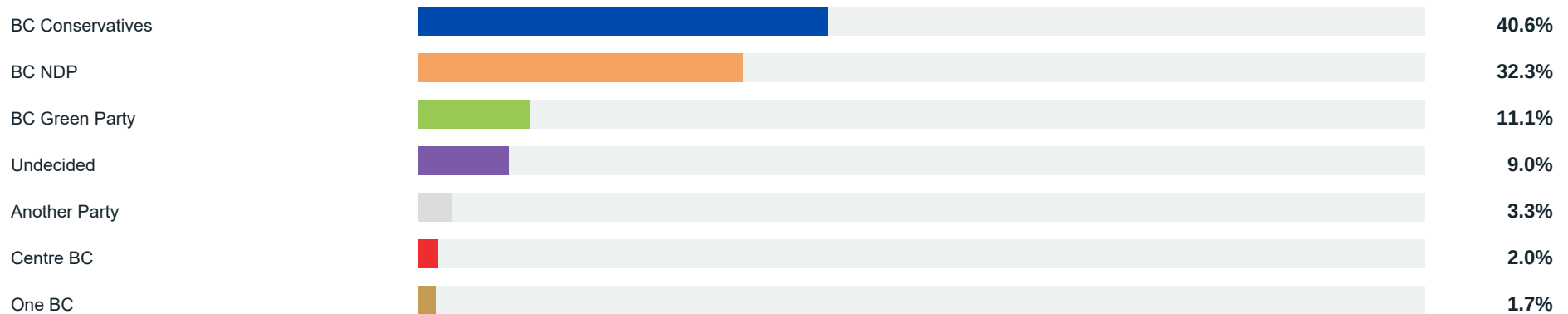

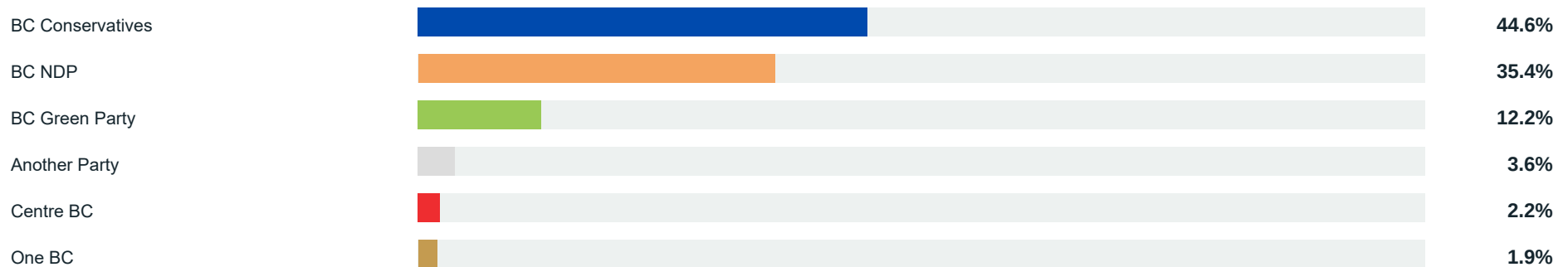
If a provincial election were held today, which party would you support?

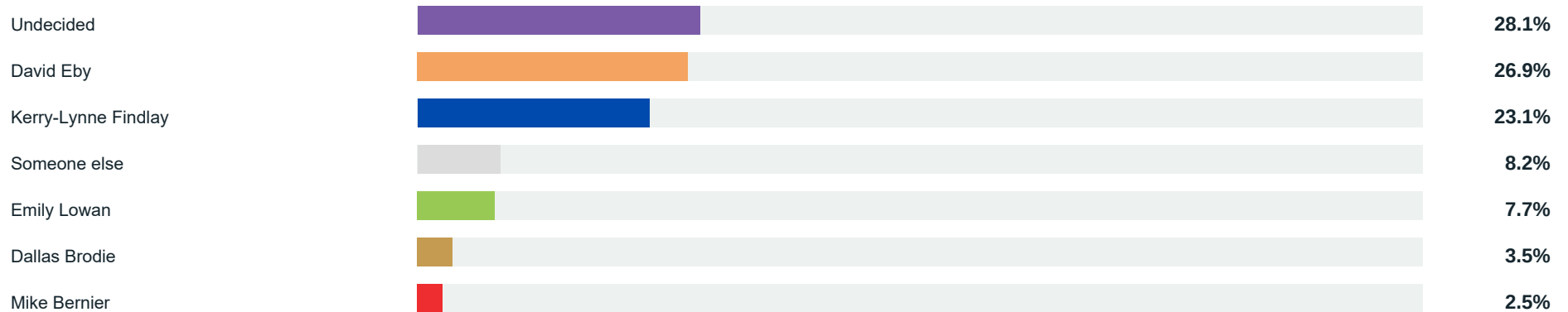

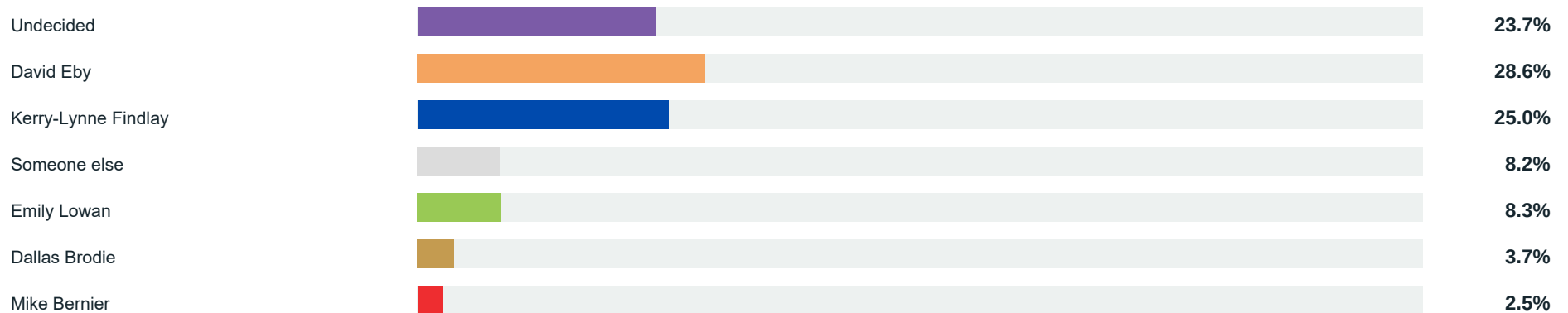

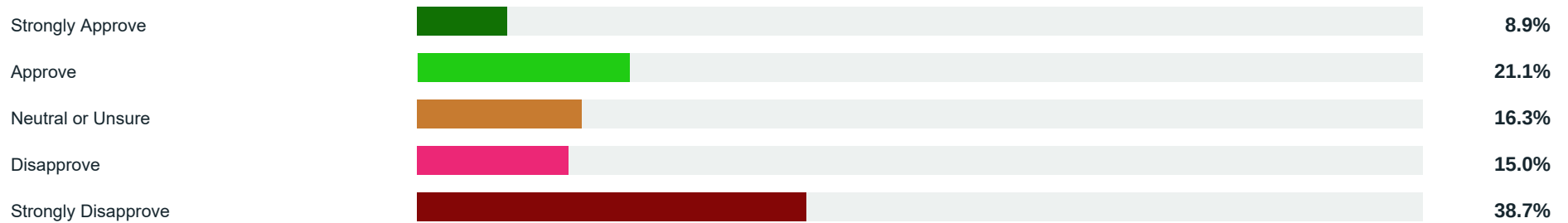
